Sir:-

Kent Black Bear, one of our Pine Ridge students, is reported by the physician as probably unable to go through the winter. His disease is Consumption. They receive such inhuman treatment from the medicine men, that I have felt it best they should remain with us to the end. With this in view, I wrote to Dr. McGillicuddy, who replies that, "Indian like, his father wants him sent home". I have, therefore, to request transportation from Carlisle to Gordon, Neb. for one. He is able to go without escort. The nearness of cold weather makes it desirable he
